## **DETERMINATION:**

1 March 2013

- 1. On 22 February 2013 the Panel gave notice of a meeting to be held under section 32 of the Takeovers Act 1993 ("the Act") in relation to Montagu's partial takeover offer for 50.001% of the voting rights in RPL.
- 2. The Panel held a meeting in Auckland on 1 March 2013 to consider the matters at issue.
- 3. The Panel has determined under section 32(3)(a) of the Act that it is satisfied that RPL and its directors and Montagu and its directors acted in compliance with the Code.
- 4. The Panel will issue reasons for its determination as soon as possible.
- 5. The Panel revokes with immediate effect all temporary restraining orders made on 22 February 2013.
- 6. The Panel will deal with costs separately in terms of the Takeovers (Fees) Regulations 2001.
